

ISPC congregational Prayers Announcement and Rules

Since state of California has allowed the religious services indoors and outdoors, meaning that ISPC Masjid can be re-open for congregational prayers, especially Friday congregational prayers.

We are planning to restart congregational prayers inside the Mosque.

Following are the rules for allowing the attendance to the congregational prayers:

1) Mandatory rules:

1.1) Prayer Rugs.

1.1.1) Prayer rug sharing shall not be allowed.

1.1.2) Bring your own prayer rugs.

1.1.3) No one shall be allowed to pray or prostrate directly on Masjid rugs/ Carpets.

1.1.4) Place the prayer rugs in designated areas only.

1.1.5) when leaving after prayers, please take your rug back with you.

1.2) Face Masks

1.2.1) Face masks are mandatory to enter the Masjid.

1.2.2) No one without the mask shall be allowed to enter the Masjid.

1.2.3) ISPC does not have face masks in their possession. It is important that you come to Masjid with your own mask.

1.2.4) Masks have to be worn all the time while inside Masjid.

1.3) Hand Sanitization

1.3.1) ISPC will provide hand sanitizers at each entry points.

1.3.2) As soon as one enters the Masjid, hand sanitization is an absolute requirement.

1.3.3) when leaving the Masjid, hand sanitization is again strongly recommended.

1.4) No crowding inside or at the entry and exit points.

1.4.1) 6 feet distance rule has to be applied when entering or exiting the prayer room.

1.4.2) especially when leaving the prayer room, it must be done in an organized, row by row basis.

1.5) Juma Congregation logistics

1.5.1) Juma prayer time will be limited to 15 minutes.

1.5.2) 1:25 Khutba Azan

5-6 minute Khutba

5-6 minutes salat

Salat to be done by 1:40

1.6) Pray Sunnahs and Navafil including Taraveeh at home.

1.7) No discussion shall be allowed inside the prayer room.

1.8) All greetings/salutations to be done outside the prayer room following the CDC rules.
